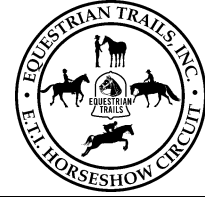

- « Check English or Western on application when signing up. Change of tack and attire start points over.
- φ Halter class entry is based on the horse; owner may assign someone as the handler for these classes.
- ◆ Walk/Trot may enter Country Pleasure, Trot Crossrails, Halter, W/T Trail, and Showmanship. Walk/Trot may NOT enter leadline classes.
- ✂ Novice Rider - open to riders that have not won 3 first place ribbons per class (i.e. equitation or pleasure) in the prior year.
- ◀ May not enter any other Over Fences/Jumping classes, except pony classes when offered. Trot Crossrail fences #39 and 40 must be taken at the trot. Crossrail fences 41 and 42 must be taken at the canter. Riders may not enter all Crossrail classes. Riders either enter the Trot Crossrail classes or the regular Crossrail classes.
- ✂ 1st & 2nd Year Green horses only.
- Show chair may offer either as listed or combined E/W.
- ⊠ May not enter any none leadline class.
- ⊠ Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle accepted.

ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MAY NOT HANDLE OR SHOW A STALLION WHILE ON SHOW GROUNDS

NO REFUNDS WITHOUT VET CERTIFICATE

Conducted under USEF and ETI High Point Program Rules, but Management Rules take precedence.

Decision of Judge is final.

No one under 18 years of age may handle or show a stallion.

No switching of numbers or horses will be allowed.

Unsportsmanship like conduct will result in disqualification.

Abuse of horses will result in disqualification and removal from show grounds.

Classes with 3 or less entrants may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of show management.

All mounted Hunt Seat riders must be wearing an ASTM approved helmet while on the show grounds.

For High Point of the Day you must maintain either Western or English attire for all classes.

I understand that as a competitor it is up to me to know all of the rules contained in this rulebook and will ask questions if I do not understand a particular rule or rules.
